

## Survey of Advisees

When faculty in the College of Education are reviewed for reappointment, promotion, and/or tenure, a survey of advisees is conducted to assist in the evaluation of the advisor's effectiveness. The Department Chair contacts a stratified sample of a candidate's advisees (some named by the faculty candidate, others selected randomly from the faculty candidate's list of assigned advisees) and asks the students/ alumni to comment on the following:

- Accessibility during office hours and by appointment
- Knowledge of the program and your progress through the program
- Knowledge of university or departmental policies and procedures
- Accuracy of advice
- General effectiveness as an academic advisor
- Any other qualities of an academic advisor you would like to mention
